It's that time of year again when the National Hydrogen Association looks for responsible, dependable, and enthusiastic volunteers to assist staff in hosting the 2010 NHA Hydrogen Conference and Expo! This year's Conference, *Green Energy, Green Jobs, Green planet*, will be held in Long Beach, California, May 3 – May 5, 2010. Specifically, the NHA is seeking students at universities with an interest in learning more about hydrogen and fuel cell technology but constrained by a limited budget. (While priority will be given to students, candidates with other backgrounds will also be considered.)

Volunteers must be available to attend a one-hour orientation session, tentatively scheduled for 11:00 am on Monday, May 3rd and be flexible for the remainder of Monday in order to assist staff with side meetings and conference preparations as needed. Sessions are scheduled from Tuesday, May 4th and Wednesday, May 5th.

Responsibilities include:

- Assist session moderators by keeping track of time during breakout sessions and act as the troubleshooter if a situation arises during the session,
- Assist in preloading speaker presentations onto session laptop computers,
- Ensure proper traffic flow in the corridors between breakout sessions, into the Plenary sessions, at the registration desk, and periodically between the hotel and convention center,
- Deliver messages to staff and conference participants during sessions,
- Assist staff with poster sessions, signage and the exhibit booth.
